Time and again, the ASEAN Way and its regional centralization has proven challenging for policy changes to stick.


It has, for so long, taken EU as a model for Regional Organization, but has often taken the passive stance in regional foreign policy.


It's passiveness roots from its colonial history, exagerated by the normalized hedging among member states.






Figure 4. Weighted Words Statistics for Chosen Topic Clusters in the ASEAN Member Countries' Speeches in the UNGDC



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
People Latent Semantic Scaling


